



On-ground training program 2024 Registration of Interest

This course is for practitioners, contractors and ecologists who are working on Natural Resource Management (NRM) projects delivered through the Australian Government Panel of Regional Delivery partners.

The EMSA on-ground training program will:

- Demonstrate key field data collection methods and techniques (including app data entry, equipment use, data and sample management)
- build knowledge and understanding of how the EMSA protocols can be used by NRM projects
- improve understanding of EMSA module dependencies and data workflows
- provide practical experience selecting and laying out an EMSA plot; and implementing the vegetation modules
- include a case-study example illustrating the workflows and logistics required to implement EMSA monitoring
- assist in accessing additional resources and onground support.

EMSA modules have been developed by TERN (Terrestrial Ecosystem Research Network) for the Australian Government Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water to support Australian Government investment programs.













Training Cost: The cost of training is covered by the Australian Government Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water, as part of the EMSA roll-out. There will, however be a cost of approximately \$400 - \$600 pp for the four day program to cover accommodation, catering and transfers to and from the nearest city/regional centre. The exact cost will depend on your training location.
